1. Instructions for Offline Personal Interview:

- a) Candidates are required to reach the venue on time for the allotted date-slot

For Forenoon Slot: The candidate Reporting timing is *8:00 – 9:00 am* and should be available until his/her PI process is over.

For Afternoon Slot: The candidate Reporting timing is *12:30 - 1.30 pm* and should be available the until his/her PI process is over.
