

Cut-off percentile for PI of Common Admission Process 2026

Following is the sectional and overall percentile cut-off for Common Admission Process 2026 of 3 participating IIMs (IIM Bodh Gaya, IIM Jammu, IIM Sirmaur) for the MBA Program.

The CAP 2026 is a joint initiative of three IIMs to conduct PI for MBA 2026-28 batch which includes the MBA & MBA specialized programs. The process involves two stages:

Stage I: Submission of Expression of Interest for the program based on the respective cutoff. This is a mandatory step but not a call for PI. Based on the CAT 2025 percentile and the number of intake slots, candidates will be shortlisted for Stage II. The participating Institute reserves the right to shortlist the number of candidates for Stage II. The shortlisted candidates will be receiving separate notifications.

Stage II: After getting shortlisted from Stage I, candidate has to pay Application fee and select the PI slot as per the availability (Stage II option will only be available to Stage I shortlisted candidates).

Please note that the actual section-wise and total percentile may be higher than the minimum cut-off percentiles provided in the above table as it will depend on the final number of candidates called for the PI process.

If a candidate is shortlisted for multiple programs, only a single PI will be conducted and the resulting scores will be used for the further process. For the further stages, academic cut-offs, and the weights allocated to the evaluation parameters may vary across IIMs. For more information, refer to the admission policies of individual IIMs on their respective websites.

The admission policy, merit list finalization, and subsequent admission offers are independent at all three IIMs. Based on the candidate's position in the merit rank and other admission criteria, the provisional admission offer will be shared by respective IIMs.

Note: Above cut-off is for MBA only. Kindly visit the official websites of the respective three IIMs for the cut-off information of their specialized MBA programs.
